## FAQ OF TIC ART GALLERY AT DERMAGA DI RAJA.

- **1.** How do I go to the Brunei International Airport? By taxi or by bus which is about 15 minutes from here.
- 2. a) How do I go on a River Cruise?

Water taxis are **available along Yayasan Jetty** you can call them anytime you want to go on river cruise. The **standard rate** is between **B\$20.00- to B\$30.00 per person**.

- 3. How can I go on a Proboscis Monkey and the Mangrove forest tour? Proboscis Monkey can be found on a 15 minutes boat ride from Yayasan Jetty. It is recommended to see the proboscis monkey early in the morning and in the late afternoon. It's advisable to use a licence local tour guide to bring you around.
- 4. a) How can I go to Kampong Ayer Cultural and Tourism Gallery? The Kampong Ayer Cultural and Tourism Gallery is just located across the Dermaga Diraja, you can go there by water taxi. The fare ranges B\$0.50 to B\$1.00 per person.
  b) Can we go around the houses in Kampong Ayer? Yes, but please seek permission from the owner of the house if you want to enter.
- 5. a) Can I go to Temburong for a day tour?

Yes you can but only to Bangar Town not for Ulu- Ulu Resort and canopy walk.b) It is possible for me to go to Ulu- Ulu resort and Canopy walk for a day?Yes, if only you go early in the morning as from Bandar to Bangar's town Jetty takes about 45 minutes and return to Bandar also take 45 minutes to arrive Kianggeh's Jetty.

c) Can I go to Temburong or Ulu- Ulu resort by my own without tour guide?No, because you need to hire a licenced tour operator that brings tourist to Temburong and Ulu- Ulu Resort.

6. Where can I find the nearest local restaurant on Brunei food?

The **Tamu Selera** which is only **15 minutes walking distance** and the **nearest** one you can go to **Tarindak Restaurant beside Arts and Handicraft Centre** about **10 minutes walking distance**.

7. Where is the nearest souvenir shop?

The nearest is at Kampong Ayer Cultural and Tourism Gallery and Yayasan Sultan Haji Hassanal Bolkiah Shopping Complex. There is also a souvenir shop at Royal Regalia Building, Arts and Handicraft Centre and at Happy Star's shop just across the Art Gallery.

8. What are the visiting hours of the Mosque in Brunei?

The visiting hours of the mosque (meaning entry into the building, not compound) are from Sunday to Wednesday at 8.00 a.m. – 12.00 p.m., 1.30 p.m. – 3.00 p.m. and 4.30 p.m. – 5.30 p.m., Friday at 4.30 p.m. - 5.30 p.m., while being closed to non-Muslims on Thursdays.
