

FAQ OF TIC KAMPONG AYER CULTURAL AND TOURISM GALLERY

1. a) How do I go for River Cruise?

Water taxi operators for river cruise can be found **at the Yayasan Jetty** next to Horizon Restaurant.

b) The standard price rate for the water taxi

The price ranges from **B\$10.00 to B\$20.00 per person.**

2. How can I go on a Proboscis Monkey and the Mangrove Forest tour?

The Proboscis Monkey can be found on **15 minutes boat ride from Yayasan Jetty.** It is **recommended** to see the proboscis monkey **early in the morning** and in the **late afternoon.** It's advised to **use licence local tour guide** to bring you around.

3. How many villages are there in Kampong Ayer?

Currently there are **34 Kampongs** and **5 Mukims.**

***Kampong = Village, *Mukim = subdivision of district.**

4. What can I see in the city? Or what are the places of interests I can visit in this area?

You can go for a **walking tour** around the city. Whereby you can go to **Kianggeh Market, Chinese Temple, Art Gallery at the Royal Wharf, Kampong Ayer Cultural and Tourism Gallery, Kampong Ayer River Cruise, 1968 Coronation Arch, Yayasan Sultan Haji Hassanah Bolkuah Shopping Complex, Sultan Haji Omar Ali Saifudien Mosque, Sultan Haji Omar Ali Saifudien Field and Royal Regalia, Arts and Handicraft Centre and Brunei Historical Centre.**

5. Where can I find the nearest local malay restaurant?

The **Tamu Selera** which is only **15 minutes walking distance** and the **nearest** one you can go to **Tarindak Restaurant** beside Arts and Handicraft Centre about **10 minutes walking distance.**
